Mr. Heard introduced Ms. Allison Bustin, Mr. Caleb Racicot and Mr. Joe Cooley with TSW, as well as Mr. Richard Fangmann, with Pond & Company.

Mr. Racicot presented the first public draft of the proposed code, which reflects guidelines and best practices. He noted that the document is a draft to be reviewed for feedback and changes in preparation for the final draft. Mr. Racicot reviewed 13 articles as provisions for current zoning and development regulations and procedures.

After the presentation, Mr. Heard asked Mayor and Council to review the complete draft of the UDC during the month of March, so that any questions or suggestions can be addressed prior to the April 2017 City Council Meeting; and further discussion ensued.

7. Adjournment

Mayor Copeland called for a motion to adjourn. Mayor Pro Tem Pruitt motioned, and Councilmember Stewart seconded. All stood in favor.
