The Special Called Meeting of the City of McDonough City Council was held on Friday, January 22, 2021, at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Copeland called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Copeland called for a motion to approve the Agenda. Councilmember Stewart motioned and Councilmember Vincent seconded. The vote was five in favor. Those voting in favor were Mayor Copeland, Mayor Pro Tem Elrod, Councilmember Stewart, Councilmember Varner and Councilmember Vincent. Councilmember B. Pruett and Councilmember R. Pruitt were not present for the meeting.

Councilmember Varner led the Pledge to the Flag.

Councilmember Stewart gave the Invocation.

City Administrator Mr. Preston Dorsey and Public Works Director Mr. Ronnie Thompson briefly reviewed information related to the Jonesboro Road Park Development Construction bids that were received by the City. Mr. Dorsey noted that the lowest bid was received from McLeRoy, Inc.; and he requested approval from Mayor and Council to move forward with the project.

Mayor Copeland called for a motion to approve for the Jonesboro Road Park Development Construction Project to be awarded to McLeRoy, Inc. at a cost of \$640,000.00 plus, a ten percent contingency and all of the funds will be paid from SPLOST IV. Councilmember Stewart motioned and Councilmember Vincent seconded. The vote was five in favor. The motion passed. Those voting in favor were Mayor Copeland, Mayor Pro Tem Elrod, Councilmember Stewart, Councilmember Varner and Councilmember Vincent. Councilmember B. Pruett and Councilmember R. Pruitt were not present at the meeting.

Mayor Copeland adjourned the meeting at 6:05 p.m.
